Deepening Our Discipleship

Whenever I have to address something and I just don't know how to start, these words from Lewis Caroll's "The Walrus and the Carpenter" come to mind:

The time has come to talk about the future staffing needs of Farmington Presbyterian. I get asked fairly regularly if Doug's absence is noticed yet. Yes, absolutely! As much as we planned and prepared, we felt his absence immediately.

After 9.5 years of ministry with us, we may be tempted to look for someone to fill Doug's absence. However, we will not find another Doug Barr. God makes us all unique for a reason and with particular purposes. Doug was called away from here because God has a vision for something new not only for Doug, but also for Farmington Presbyterian Church.

The first seeds of the vision were planted over a year ago as Session discussed the needs of our church and our ministry to the Day School and the community. The vision began to sprout as we prayerfully considered the needs and possibilities before us. Session has discerned that we will be seeking an Associate Pastor for Community Life and has determined that the communications work that was part of Doug's job description will be handled through redistribution of responsibilities and out-sourcing.

The Associate Pastor for Community Life will have skills in community building and pastoral care. This person will have responsibility for ministry with children and youth, including serving in an intentional chaplaincy role to the Day School students and families, and for implementing opportunities to get to know our community, both in the Day School and the surrounding neighborhoods, and welcome them as an active part of the Farmington family.
